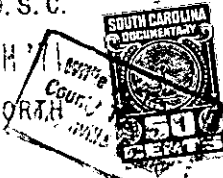

That, John C. Kilgore, of the County of Jefferson and State of Texas, has this day made, constituted and appoint and by these presents does make, constitute and appoint Frank R. Kilgore of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place and stead, to execute any and all instrument or instruments, conveyances covering all my interest in real estate inherited by me from my father, J. C. Kilgore, deceased and also in the settlement of my mother's, Helen G. Kilgore, deceased, estate, giving and granting to my said attorney full power and authority to settle all claim or claims either for or against me covering my interest in said estate and to give such releases as may be necessary in the settlement of said estate, hereby giving and granting to my said attorney the power to do any and every act and exercise any and every power that I might or could do or exercise through any other person and that he shall deem proper or advisable intending hereby to vest in him full and universal power of attorney, hereby giving and granting to said attorney full power and authority to do and perform any and all acts and things whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully and to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that said attorney or substitute shall lawfully do in the premises by virtue hereof.
