KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Eustace E. Bennett, of the County and State aforesaid,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Henry Hudson Bennett, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described property, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Taylors, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described according to a plat entitled "Survey for P.A. and Mattie Bennett Estate, Taylors, South Carolina", made by Carolina Surveying Company, the same being designated as Lot No. 5 on a plat, above referred to, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the north side of a proposed road 105.6 feet east of its intersection with a County Road, and running thence S. 1-40 E. 545.2 feet to a point in the center of Marrow Bone Creek; thence with the center of Marrow Bone Creek as the line S. 58-30 E. 83.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18-42 W. 68.9 feet to a point in the center of Marrow Bone Creek; thence with the center of Marrow Bone Creek as the line S. 61-54 E. 44.9 feet to a point in the center of Marrow Bone Creek; thence N. 1-40 W. 618.5 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of a proposed road; thence with the southwest side of said proposed road N. 56-00 W. 105.00 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of said proposed road, the point of beginning, and containing 1.2 acres more or less.

This deed is made subject to any restrictions, easements and rights-of-way that may appear of record and/or on the recorded plat an/or on the premises.

This is a portion of the same property conveyed to the Grantor by heirs of Mattie Bennett by deed being recorded simultaneous herewith in Deed Book 932, at page 365.
