in consideration of -----ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00)----- Dollars,

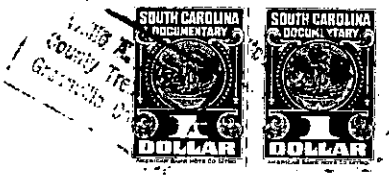
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto GINO L. R. TROMBINI AND SHIRLEY TROMBINI, their heirs and assigns, forever, one-half (1/2) of the following described property:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 131 on Plat of addition to Greenbriar recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book AAA at Page 61, having a common line with Lot No. 130 now owned by the grantees herein with approximate metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Fairlane Drive joint corner with Lot No. 130 and running along said common boundary for a distance of two hundred feet to an iron pin, the same being a joint corner; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 131 for a distance of 49.7 feet; thence two hundred feet to a point midway of the front boundary line of Lot No. 131 facing Fairlane Drive; thence along Fairlane Drive to the beginning joint corner of Lot No. 130 and Lot No. 131.

It being the intention of the grantor and grantees to divide said Lot No. 131 equally with the other half of Lot No. 131 to be conveyed by the grantor herein to the owner of Lot No. 132 by additional deed of even date.

This being one-half (1/2) of Lot No. 131 formerly conveyed to the grantor by deed recorded in Book 783 of Deeds, Page 213, R. M. C. Office of Greenville County.
