Pettit, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, containing three (3) acres, more or less, being a part of that certain property conveyed to Charles E. Mosteller by Ethel J. Hunsinger by deed dated August 7, 1943, recorded in Deed Book 255 at page 290 in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of S.C. Highway 93 at the intersection of the center of said Highway and the center of a county road known as Blue Ridge Drive, and running thence with the center of said Blue Ridge Drive, S. 13-47 W., 289 feet; thence leaving said Blue Ridge Drive and running with the center of a county road, S. 74-05 W., 217 feet; thence leaving said county road and running N. 45-00 W., 258 feet to an old iron pin; thence running N. 36-10 E., 325 feet (through an old iron pin at 300 feet) to a point in the center of S. C. Highway 93; thence with the center of said S. C. Highway 93, S. 69-10 E., 287 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions, zoning ordinances, setback lines, roads or passageways, easements and rights of way, if any, affecting the above described property.
