ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, known as Tract No. 6 of the P. D. Roper Estate as shown by plat of Howard Caldwell dated November, 1941, and recorded in Book "M" at Page 41, and thereon more fully described as follows:
