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and the County of Greenville;

NOW, THEREFORE, the County of Greenville, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby agrees that the road known in previous years as the Paris Mountain Road and which is not now in use by the County and the general public and which is of no further use to the County as a road, be and is hereby closed to the traveling public and the County of Greenville does hereby expressly release and quitclaim unto Ronald W. Howard Jr., his heirs and assigns, forever, all of its right, title and interest in and to said property, if any, by virtue of the abandoned road pursuant to its reservation in the deed to A.G. New as set forth above unto Ronald W. Howard Jr., his heirs and assigns forever.

It is understood and agreed that Greenville County does hereby release Ronald W. Howard Jr., his heirs and assigns, from the force and effect of the restrictions or protective covenant pertaining to residences and prohibiting businesses on the property conveyed to T. C. Gower and W. D. Parrish by Mary F. Goldsmith in order that Ronald W. Howard Jr., his heirs and assigns, or one purchasing from this estate, might hereafter use said property for any purpose which is lawful, including residential business, industrial or otherwise. The effect intended herein is to cancel entirely so far as the County of Greenville is able any restriction as to residences or as to prohibiting businesses being used, operated or constructed on said premises above described.
