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which shall be pertinent to identify the mortgage or mortgages. The holders of any mortgage or mortgages upon any unit, if they so desire, shall notify Association of the existence of any mortgage or mortgages held by such party on any Unit, and upon receipt of such notice, Association shall register in its records all pertinent information pertaining to the same.

## XXV.

ASSESSMENTS: LIABILITY, LIEN AND ENFORCEMENT

Association is given the authority to administer the operation and management of The Highlands Horizontal Property Regime, it being recognized that the delegation of such duties to one entity is in the best interest of the owners of all Units. To properly administer the operation and management of the Project, Association will incur, for the mutual benefit of all the co-owners of units, costs and expenses which will be continuing or non-recurring costs, as the case may be, which costs and expenses are sometimes herein referred to as "common expense". To provide the funds necessary for such proper operation and management, the Association has heretofore been granted the right to make, levy and collect assessments against the co-owners of all Units. In furtherance of said grant of authority to Association to make, levy and collect assessments to pay the costs and expenses for the operation and management of The Highlands Horizontal Property Regime, the following provisions shall be operative and binding upon the co-owners of all Units to-wit:

A. All assessments levied against the co-owners of Units shall be uniform and, unless specifically otherwise provided for in this Master Deed, the assessments made by Association shall be in such proportion that the amount of assessment levied against each co-owner of a Unit shall bear the same ratio to the total assessment made against all co-owners of Units as the undivided interest in General Common Elements and Limited Common Elements appurtenant to each Unit bears to the total undivided interest in General Common Elements and Limited Common Elements appurtenant to all Units. Should Association be the owner of any Units, the assessment which would otherwise be due and payable to Association by the co-owner of such Unit will be reduced by the amount of income which may be derived from the leasing of such Unit by Association, and the balance shall be apportioned and assessment therefor levied ratably among the co-owners of all Units
