ALL that certain parcel or tract of land, in Highland Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, located about one mile Southwest of Highland Baptist Church and lying eastward from Barton Road, bounded on the North and East by lands of Preston McKinney and on the South and West by Lettie Mae Moore and having the following courses and distances: -
