WHEREAS, for valuable consideration, receipt acknowledged, First Piedmont Bank and Trust Company does agree for itself, its successors and assigns, not to enforce or attempt to enforce collection of judgment against Leonard R. Weir and Betty S. Weir, it being understood that the Bank retains all monies collected to date on executions previously issued;

NOW, THEREFORE, First Piedmont Bank and Trust Company does simultaneously herewith assign, without recourse, to L. R. Weir and Betty S. Weir all rights it may have in and to said judgment against the remaining defendants as to the balance due on said judgments after deducting the amount it received from the Sheriff's sale of personal property of certain equipment held in Lexington, South Carolina, on Tuesday, July 25, 1972, which the Bank is entitled to retain.
