All that piece, parcel or lot of land with improvements thereon situate, lying, and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and situate on the northern side of Brushy Creek Road and being known and designated as Lot 2 on plat entitled Property of William B. Ducker by Dalton & Neves, dated January 1960 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book UU at Page 1, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Brushy Creek Road, at the front corner of Lot No. 2, said point being 200 feet from the intersection of Brushy Creek Road with Lee Road, and running thence with the line of Lot 2 N. 11-53 E. 87.1 feet to an iron pin; thence running S. 72-53 E. 83.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence with the common line of said Lots S. 0-17 E. 128.5 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Brushy Creek Road; thence with the line of said Road N. 54-32 W. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with line of said Road N. 57-0 W. 45 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantors herein by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 934, at Page 216.

As a part of the consideration herein, the grantees assume and agree to pay that certain mortgage in favor of First Federal Savings & Loan Association, in the principal amount of \$17,000.00, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Mortgage Book 1219, at Page 653, and having a present principal balance due thereon of \$16,894.56.

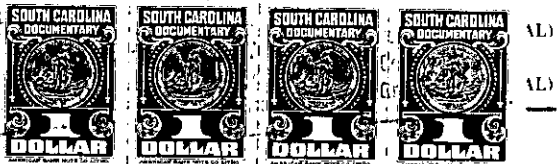
