

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is exclusively Religious, Charitable, Educational, and recreational; to conduct religious Services, Ceremonies, and schools; and to exercise certain moral and spiritual and charitable functions consistent with Christian Doctrine to serve God by the principles of the Pentecostal and Apostolic Faith and Disciplines; and to cooperate with other groups of like concern. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Deacons and Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine.

Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the Fifth: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:

SIXTH: That they desire to be incorporated: in perpetuity

Now, THEREFORE, I, O FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 13, Title 12, Code of 1962, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 13, Title 12, Code of 1962, and Acts amendatory thereto.
