(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George Raymond Fowler, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described property:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as a portion of Lots 136 and 137; as shown on on a plat of the property of Isaqueena Park, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book P at pages 130 and 131, and having according to a more recent survey prepared by J. C. Hill, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Kirkwood Lane, said iron pin being 360 feet in a Westerly direction from the intersection of Kirkwood Lane and Oxford Street, and running thence S. 43-57 W. 148.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 49 W. 60.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 35-40 E. 156.7 feet to an iron pin on Kirkwood Lane; thence with said Kirkwood Lane, S. 48-51 E. 42 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said Kirkwood Lane, S. 40-59 E. 46 feet, to the point of beginning."
