in the State aforesaid receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Shelton J. Rimer, his heirs and assigns, forever:

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in Glassey Mountain Township and on the waters of Morgan Creek and bounded as follows: On the North by lands of Jacob Bellew Estate; on the East by Jefferson Howard and C. D. Lindsay; on the South by the lands of Levi Bowers heirs; on the West by the land of Rebecca Bowers and a portion of the North by land of Nancy Harrison. Being that land conveyed to W. Carroll McDaniel and James H. Patton by Rachel Lindsay and containing 95 acres, more or less.
