Frank B. Halter,

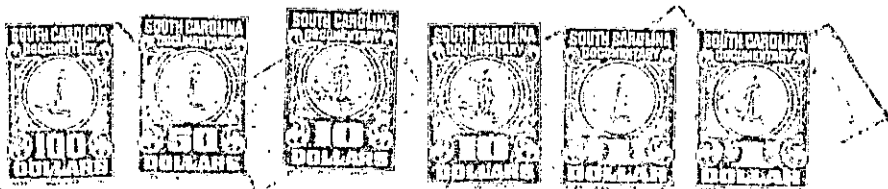
