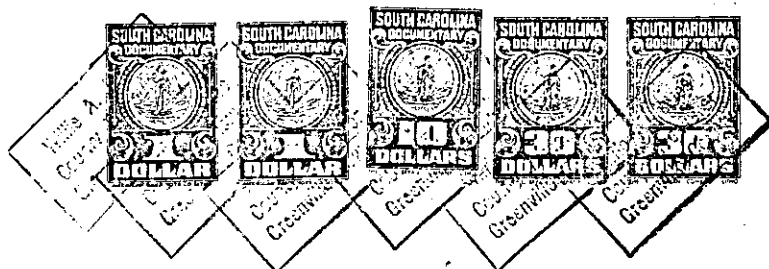

D. Garrison, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4R at Page 1, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Golden Grove Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 18 and running thence with the common line of said Lots, S. 11-16 W. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence running S. 78-44 E. 120 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19; thence running with the common line of said Lots, N. 11-16 E. 210 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern side of Golden Grove Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19; thence running with the southwestern side of Golden Grove Circle, N. 78-44 W. 120 feet to the point of beginning.
