All that piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 198 of a subdivision known as Pebble Creek, Phase I as shown on plat thereof prepared by Enwright Associates, Engineers, dated October 1973, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 5-D at Page 2 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Applejack Lane, joint front corner of Lots 198 and 199 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 56-19 E. 154.24 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 43-49 W. 115.45 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 197 and 198; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 55-24 W. 156.66 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Applejack Lane; thence with said Lane the following courses and distances: S. 17-00 E. 20 feet, S. 17-03 E. 34.9 feet and S. 67-02 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
