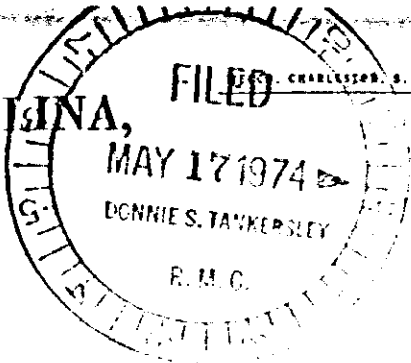


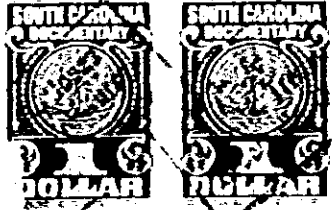

acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said Thomas E. Thornhill, his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
described property, to wit:

All that lot or parcel of land located in Cleveland Township, Greenville  
County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 2, Section A, of  
the Caesar's Head Development and being more particularly described as  
follows:

Beginning at a stake on the east side of Sunrise Drive at the corner of  
Lot #4 and running thence N. 62-04 W. 100 feet to a stake; thence S. 30-  
23 W. 112 feet to a stake; thence S. 50-51 E. 99.5 feet to a stake; thence
