A family cemetery reserved in the deed from Clarence E. Ballenger, Jr., et al., to Travis J. Cash, et al., dated March 16, 1963, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 721 at page 325, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern corner of cemetery which said beginning point being N. 61-10 W. 764 feet from an original Southeastern corner of the Albertson property and mutual corner of Roy Smith property and running thence N. 89 W. 53 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-30 E. 42 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 80-40 E. 38.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 6 E. 35.5 feet to the beginning corner; the decedents and relatives of those buried in said cemetery to have the right of ingress to and egress from the cemetery over the conveyed premises.

The within conveyance is subject to all restrictions, setback lines, zoning ordinances, utility easements and rights of way, if any, affecting the above described property.

This is the identical property conveyed to the Grantor herein by deed of The Kostner Corporation, dated December 30, 1974, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
