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It is further recommended that the Trustee maintain intact all of the present securities which the Settlor has, but this also is not required.

10. Settlor's home. The Settlor shall continue to reside at 3 Harcourt Drive, Greenville, South Carolina, so long as her health permits or until the property is condemned by the highway department. A written statement by any two (2) of the Settlor's three (3) daughters shall be sufficient authorization for the Trustee to make any necessary arrangements for the Settlor to reside elsewhere.

11. Settlor's disability. If the Settlor shall become disabled by reason of illness or mental or physical disability, or in the opinion of the Trustee the Settlor is unable to properly administer such amounts payable directly to the Settlor, then such amounts payable directly to the Settlor shall be paid by the Trustee in any one of the following ways as the Trustee, in its sole discretion, deems best:

- (1) Directly to the legally appointed guardian, attorney-in-fact, or committee of the Settlor;
- (2) To some relative or friend who has accepted the responsibility for caring, supporting and looking after the Settlor; or
- (3) By the Trustee using such amounts directly for such Settlor's care, support and welfare.
