lawfully do in and about the premises, by virtue hereof.

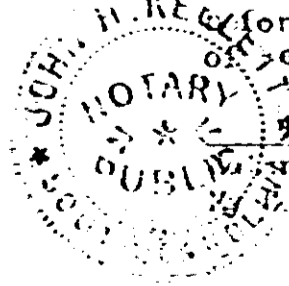
