FURTHER, I do authorize my aforesaid Attorney-in-Fact to perform all necessary acts in the execution of the aforesaid authorizations, and I do hereby expressly declare that the powers herein granted to my aforesaid Attorney-in-Fact shall not be construed as limited to those matters hereinbefore specifically set forth, but rather shall be construed broadly to include and embrace full and unlimited power and authority to do and perform, on my behalf and in my place and stead and with equal validity, any and all other lawful acts or things which I could do if personally present; hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever my said Attorney-in-Fact shall and may do, by virtue hereof, in the premises.

The powers granted herein are to be effective perpetually unless revoked by Donor.
