This matter comes before the Court upon a verified Complaint of the plaintiffs in the above captioned action and it appears that the plaintiffs seek to establish an easement or a prescriptive right to use a certain road leading from property owned by the plaintiffs and the class which they represent (which tract of land would otherwise be landlocked) across property of the defendants to a public highway known as Jug Factory Road or Wingo Road, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina. In addition, the Complaint shows that the plaintiffs seek to require the defendants, and mainly the defendants William Cephus Turner and Sharon K. Turner, to remove all obstructions placed across the road and to prevent the placing of any further obstructions in said road and from having the defendants or anyone claiming by and through them from interfering in any way with the use and enjoyment of said road by the plaintiffs and their heirs and assigns. The action is therefore one in equity.
