

It is further understood and agreed that the State Agency of Vocational Rehabilitation has the right to construct drainage pipes underneath the alley herein referred to from the property of the Agency to the point where the Agency connects with the right-of-way of the State Highway Department on the western side of Laurens Road, said drainage system to be paid for in full by the said State Agency and that all efforts will be made to close said alley at the least number of working days and that said engineering construction of said alley will be conducted in such a manner as to cause a minimum of inconvenience to the parties to this instrument.

It is further understood and agreed that the grantors and grantee in this instrument mutually agree that they will not separately or jointly use said alley in a manner to prevent the free use of said alley by other parties to this Agreement. It being understood that the three (3) parties, the grantors and the grantee, are to have equal rights to the use of said alley.

Since this Agreement requires the understanding and the rights of the three (3) parties, the instrument shall be executed by all three (3) parties in triplicate, each signed copy to be considered as an original.

It being understood that this easement binds the grantors and the grantee, their heirs, successors and assigns.
