KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, WALTER EMORY MARTIN,

in consideration of One Thousand Four Hundred Sixteen and 66/100--(\$1,416.66)---Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto **SOUTHSIDE BAPTIST CHURCH**, an eleemosynary corporation, all my undivided 1/6 interest in and to the following described property:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville, county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, being a portion of Lot 1, Block A, subdivision of Kanatenah, shown on plat recorded in Plat Book F, pages 131-132 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the southerly side of Oregon Street, corner of property of the grantee, and running thence with the line of the grantee's property, S. 25-31 E. 55 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 2; thence N. 65-35 E. 30 feet 4 inches to an iron pin; thence N. 25-31 W. 55 feet to an iron pin on the southerly side of Oregon Street; thence with the southerly side of said street, S. 65-35 W. 30 feet 4 inches to the beginning corner.

The above described lot of land was conveyed to Haskell H. Martin by deed from Lucille H. Spann recorded April 23, 1946 in deed volume 293 at page 380; subsequently Haskell H. Martin conveyed to Haskell H. Martin, Jr. and Judson C. Martin a 1/3 interest each by deed recorded in deed volume 354 at page 181; subsequently Haskell H. Martin died testate October, 1971 leaving all of his property to his wife, Carobel Cooley Martin, as will appear by reference to his will recorded in Apartment 1202, file 6 of the Probate Court for Greenville County; subsequently Carobel Cooley Martin died testate leaving her 2/3 interest in the property to her children, and also deed from Ben M. Spann to Haskell H. Martin, Carobel Cooley Martin, and Judson C. Martin, recorded September 25, 1970 in deed volume 899 at page 259. The children of Carobel Cooley Martin are Haskell H. Martin, Jr., Judson C. Martin, Nell M. Bradley, and Walter Emory Martin.

This conveyance is made subject to any restrictions, reservations, zoning ordinances or easements that may appear of record, on the recorded plat or on the premises.
