KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that R. A. JOLLEY, JR., JAMES E. JOLLEY and MAMIE JOLLEY BRUCE

in consideration of One and No/100 (\$1.00) Dollars

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto GREENCO REALTY, INC., its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL OF OUR INTEREST IN AND TO: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the East side of North Pleasantburg Drive (S.C. Highway 291) and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the East side of Pleasantburg Drive, the same being the northwest corner of the tract owned now or formerly by Nalley Construction Company, Inc. and running thence N 84-52 E., 410.9 feet; thence S. 7-31 E. 200 feet; thence S. 84-52 W. 406.5 feet to a point of the East side of Pleasantburg Drive; thence along the East side of Pleasantburg Drive N. 8-37W. 200 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with an easement, 50 feet in width, extending from the southside of the lot of land above described and extending to the northern edge of East North Street, the same being that easement conveyed to G. B. Nalley by the deed of Lola W. Amick, et al, recorded in Deed Book 711, at Page 165, and is subject to the terms, conditions and provisions as set forth in said deed.

The above is the same property conveyed to Grantee and R. A. Jolley by deed recorded in Deed Book 719, at Page 280. R. A. Jolley deeded his one-fourth interest therein to Grantee by deed recorded April 16, 1976 in Deed Book 1034, at Page 818. R. A. Jolley is now deceased and the Grantors are the sole beneficiaries under his Last Will and Testament. This deed is executed to quitclaim any interest the Grantors may have in the above described property.
