ORDER APPOINTING RECEIVER

The application of Harpeth National Bank, Tappan Company and Airtemp Corporation, unsecured creditors of Jack L. Walker, the alleged bankrupt above-named, seeking the appointment of a receiver to take charge of the property of said alleged bankrupt, having been heard by this Court on the ____ day of January, 1978, notice not being given to all parties of interest because of the exigencies of the situation, and after hearing the attorneys for the applicants in favor of said application,

It appears that the appointment of a receiver is necessary to prevent a loss to the estate of Jack L. Walker through the dissipation, wasting, removing or concealment of assets, and

It appearing that applicants have filed a bond in the amount of \$ 5000⁰⁰, fixed as to the amount and approved as to the surety by this Court, and conditioned to indemnify the bankrupt for such costs, counsel fees, and expenses and damages as may be occasioned by the seizure, taking and detention of said property, no further notice need be given, and it is

ORDERED that George C. Paine, II be, and hereby is appointed receiver to take charge of the property of Jack L. Walker, the alleged bankrupt above-named, and to protect the interest of his creditors, it is further

ORDERED that the duties and compensation of said receiver be, and they hereby are, enlarged pursuant to Bankruptcy
