If it is necessary to disturb any of the existing fence, it will be rebuilt. During construction the contractor will be instructed to provide temporary fencing for the construction interim so that grantor's cattle will be protected.

The engineer has been instructed to flag the center line of the Western Carolina right of way from the point where it joins the Parker District line onto the southeast side of grantor's property line so that grantor can inspect it.

The grantee shall have the use of the main gate and old road bed for the movement of equipment and materials and will coordinate such use with the grantor's overseer Mr. Melton Stone.

The grantee will provide a permanent watering place for cattle and will work with Mr. Stone concerning the details of that.

The right of way and the temporary right of way, a total of \_\_\_\_\_ feet shall be cleared, although stump removal shall not be required provided the contractors cut the timber flush with the ground in order that farm equipment can function without being snagged.
