8.o. The plans for the construction of all hangars, shops, or other buildings shall be subject to the approval of the COMMISSION.

8.p. Aircraft parking aprons shall be constructed according to plans and specifications approved by the COMMISSION.

8.q. All services shall be provided on a fair, equal, and not unjustly discriminatory basis to all users of the AIRPORT. The prices charged for each unit of service shall be fair, reasonable, and not unjustly discriminatory; provided, that the operator may be allowed to make reasonable and nondiscriminatory discounts, rebates, or other similar type price reductions to volume purchasers.

8.r. The operator shall provide his services in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1967 (P.L. 88-352). Accordingly, no PERSON shall be denied equal services on the ground of race, color, or national origin.

8.s. All PERSONS or firms engaged in the sale of fuel at the AIRPORT or who otherwise store fuel for their own use, shall be subject to the same fuel flowage fee, which shall be established and changed from time to time by the COMMISSION.

SECTION 9

9. The aviation industry is in a continuous state of flux. Newer aircraft types and increases in traffic volumes demand a constant review and updating of airport facilities requirements. In keeping with the necessary updating of facilities and the provision of new facilities, the COMMISSION reserves the right to periodically review and revise, if necessary, the rules and regulations contained herein. Such revisions would be promulgated only when found to be in the best interests of the COMMISSION, the AIRPORT tenants, and all others directly or indirectly concerned with aircraft operations at Donaldson Center Industrial Air Park.

PROMULGATION

The within and foregoing Rules duly adopted by the Donaldson Development Commission in meeting assembled on the 4th day of October, 1979, are hereby promulgated under the authority granted to and vested in the Commission by the Joint Resolution between the City Council of Greenville, South Carolina, and the County Council of Greenville, South Carolina, in January 1976.
