

(10) My attorney in fact shall be entitled to the same compensation for his services that a committee duly appointed by the Probate Court would have been entitled to according to the statutory laws of the State of South Carolina.

And I, the said M. Lee Eadie, do hereby ratify and confirm all acts of my attorney, and do declare that all acts and deeds performed under this instrument shall have the same full force and effect as if performed and signed by me in person, and this instrument shall be effective until revoked in writing or shall cease by operation of law.

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate.
