

EXHIBIT "A" TO DEED FROM EXXON CORPORATION, A NEW JERSEY CORPORATION, TO

BEING at a point on the eastern right-of-way of New Duncombe Road, said point lying N. 29° 18' W. 10.53 feet from the southernmost corner of the property of Esso Standard Oil Company as purchased from J. P. Miller, et al, and as shown on a map hereinafter described, and running thence with the said eastern right-of-way of New Duncombe Road N. 29° 18' W. 10.53 feet to a point; thence, N. 42° 30' E. 150.83 feet to a point on the northeastern line of the property as shown on the aforesaid map; thence, with the said northeastern line S. 26° 33' E. 10.71 feet to a point; thence, S. 42° 30' W. 150.41 feet to the point of beginning.

BEING a portion of the property as shown on a map for Esso Standard Oil Company prepared by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, dated August 2, 1957, and recorded in Plat Book NH, page 163, Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County, South Carolina.

Being the same land as described in that certain Warranty Deed dated April 15, 1958, between Esso Standard Oil Company, Grantor, and County of Greenville, Grantee.

Esso Standard Oil Company, a Delaware corporation, merged into Humble Oil & Refining Company, a Delaware corporation, on December 31, 1959. Humble Oil & Refining Company merged into Exxon Corporation, a New Jersey corporation, on January 1, 1973.
