

In making such appointment by her Will she shall have the full and free right to appoint the corpus thereof to any person or persons, except to her estate, her creditors, or the creditors of her estate, and she may appoint to any such beneficiaries in such portion or portions as she may desire, such bequests to be free and outright, or to be imposed with such conditions or restraints as she may designate, including the power to make appointments in trust or in life estate with remainders over should she so desire. Should said Cornelia C. Balz fail to exercise this general power of appointment by her Last Will and Testament then the said amount shall be distributed to her issue, in equal shares, per stirpes.

(3) The TRUSTEE shall pay to Mrs. Carroll C. Somerville, the daughter of GRANTOR, during her lifetime the entire net income of Share 2. TRUSTEE shall also pay to Mrs. Somerville such portion of the principal of said Share 2 as may be necessary for her comfortable care, maintenance, support and education. Upon the death of Mrs. Carroll C. Somerville, the entire remaining balance of Share 2 including principal and accumulated income shall be distributed as said Mrs. Carroll C. Somerville shall appoint by her Last Will and Testament.
