BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Augusta Road, said pin being 150 feet south of the southwestern corner of the intersection of Augusta Road and East Fairfield Road and running thence S. 44-32 W. 38.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 45-48. W. 257.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 44-47 E. 201.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 56-39 E. 110 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 52-03 E. 150 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

This is a portion of that property conveyed to Cecile E. Ashmore by deed of Julia A. Eskew recorded March 2, 1937, in Deed Book 192 at page 287. Mrs. Ashmore died intestate leaving Mrs. Ella Telford as one of her heirs at law. (SEE PROBATE COURT Apt. 1092, File 15.) Mrs. Telford, predeceased, died intestate leaving Frances Latham and James Telford as two of her three heirs at law. James Telford died testate devising 1/2 of his estate to Frances Latham. Frances Latham died intestate leaving Herman E. Latham as one of her six heirs at law. Herman E. Latham died intestate leaving the grantor as one of his three heirs at law.
