

Power of Attorney. The word attorney as used herein shall include both the singular and the plural as the facts or circumstances may indicate.

9. This power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal, F. B. Bozeman which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate. It is the intent of the principal to create a durable power of attorney conferring upon his attorney in fact the power to act on behalf of the principal notwithstanding later disability or mental incompetence of the principal, pursuant to the authority of Section 32-13-10 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended.
