KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, Selma W. Surguy, my true and lawful agent and attorney in fact to act in, manage and conduct all my estate and all my affairs; and for that purpose and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit and as my act and deed, to do and execute, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself in the doing or executing of, all of the following acts, deeds, and things, that is to say:

1. To buy, receive, lease, accept, or otherwise acquire, to sell, convey, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, quit claim, or otherwise encumber or dispose of, or to contract or agree for the acquisition, disposal or encumbrance of; any property whatsoever and wheresoever situated, be it real, personal, mixed or any custody, possession, interest or right therein or pertaining thereto, upon such terms as my said attorney shall think proper.

2. To deposit and withdraw for the purposes hereof, in either my said attorney's name or my name or jointly in both of our names, or jointly with any other person or persons, in or from any banking institution, savings and loan association, or any other institution whatsoever, any funds, negotiable papers, or money which may come into my said attorney's hands as such attorney or which I now or hereafter may have on deposit or be entitled to.

3. This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate.
