

The Trustees are authorized to exercise all of the powers in the management of the trust estate which any individual could exercise in the management of similar property owned in his own right, upon such terms and conditions as to the Trustees may seem best, and to execute and deliver any and all instruments and to do all acts which the Trustees may deem proper or necessary to carry out the purposes of this trust. The Trustees shall not be entitled to compensation for such services provided. Should a Trustee be unable or unwilling to serve or continue to serve, then the remaining Trustee shall serve alone.

It is intended that this trust shall be revocable during the lifetime of the Settlor and, upon notice of revocation, the Trustees shall deliver the trust estate to the Settlor.
