

(g) The terms and conditions hereof shall inure to the benefit of and become binding upon the undersigned parties, their heirs, assigns, executors and administrators.

(h) All words used herein in the singular shall include the plural, and the masculine gender shall include the feminine.

(i) No cancellation hereof, by operation of law or otherwise, shall be effective as to any person relying upon this Power of Attorney unless such person shall have received actual notice in writing of its cancellation.

(j) A description of any real estate in which dower of the donor of this Power of Attorney has been hereunder released and renounced pursuant to South Carolina Code of Laws of 1962, Sections 19-114.1 and 19-114.2, is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A", incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof as though fully set forth.

**SURVIVAL OF PHYSICAL DISABILITY OR MENTAL INCOMPETENCE**

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate, with the purposes, intent and legal consequences set forth for a "Durable Power of Attorney" in South Carolina Code of Laws of 1976, as Amended, Section 32-13-10.
