QUITCLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that GOLDSTON, INC., a North Carolina corporation, having its principal place of business at Eden, North Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), and other valuable consideration to it in hand paid, does hereby convey and quitclaim to HERTZ PENSKE TRUCK LEASING, INC., a Delaware corporation, as Grantee, the real estate situated in the the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the southeastern side of Old Sulphur Springs Road, containing approximately 5.5 acres as shown on plat entitled "Property of Goldston Transfer, Inc." prepared by C.O. Riddle on January 30, 1969 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
