QUITCLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Reeves Brothers, Inc.,
a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of
New York, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten
and 00/100 (\$10.00) Dollars to it in hand paid at and before the
sealing of these presents by Emma Gray Memorial United Methodist
Church of Woodruff, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and
as a charitable donation by it to Emma Gray Memorial United Methodist
Church of Woodruff has granted, bargained, sold and released and by
these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Emma Gray Memorial United Methodist Church of Woodruff:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land,
lying, being and situate in the County of
Greenville, State of South Carolina, at the inter-
section of Whitehorse Road and Staunton Bridge
Road, shown and delineated on a plat entitled "Sur-
vey for Reeves Brothers, Inc.", by Piedmont Engi-
neers, Architects & Planners, dated November 11,
1982, to be recorded herewith, and referred to on
said plat as the "Mills Mfg. Co. Cemetery" contain-
ing 1.192 acres, more or less.

Said piece, parcel or tract of land was con-
veyed to The Mills Manufacturing Company, by
Aurelia T. Munn and J. R. Ware, by deed dated
April 1, 1906, recorded in Deed Book SSS, page
596, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

Mills Mill, formerly The Mills Manufacturing
Company, together with Fairforest Company, Chesnee
Mills and Warrior Duck Mills, was merged by merger
agreement recorded in Deed Book 540, page 454, in
the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and also
in Judgment Roll No. G-2699, Book 4, page 280, in
the Office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville
County, the surviving corporation of the merger be-
ing Fairforest Company, and its name was changed
thereby to Reeves Brothers, Incorporated. Reeves
Brothers, Incorporated was subsequently merged
with Reeves Brothers, Inc. by merger agreement
recorded in Deed Book 579, page 344, in the R.M.C.
Office for Greenville County, and also in Judgment
Roll No. G-7906 in the Office of the Clerk of
Court for Greenville County, the surviving corpora-
tion of the merger being Reeves Brothers, Inc.
