The right-of-way to be taken by this proceeding is for twenty-five feet (25'), the same being twelve and one-half (12½') of that survey line staked out upon your property, crossing over and through the following parcel(s) of your property as shown on the Greenville County Tax Map Sheet: 556.1-1-23

for a distance of 420 feet, more or less. This being the same property conveyed to you by the following deed reference(s):

Deed Book 1182, page 928

In addition, a temporary right-of-way for use during construction only is required. The construction right-of-way shall be twelve and one-half feet (12½') on each side of the permanent right-of-way. This temporary right-of-way shall exist only during construction.

A copy of the referenced block book is attached to this exhibit and shown thereon is the approximate location of the survey line.

Also attached is a copy of that portion of the engineering drawings, showing the said survey line in the center of said right-of-way.
