

It is the intention of the grantor to convey to the grantee all of the property acquired by E. B. Hendrix in deed recorded in Deed Book YY, Page 593.

The above described property is the same property conveyed to E. B. Hendrix by deed of John Ferguson recorded November 26 1892 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book YY, at Page 593. E. B. Hendrix died intestate August 20, 1925 survived by his wife Lula W. Hendrix and his nine children, Estelle Nettles, Robert Hendrix, Mary Hendrix, Lucille Steed, Willie Hendrix, John Hendrix, Annie Hendrix, Marguerite Hendrix, and Carroll Hendrix, as will appear by reference to Apartment No. 201, File No. 5 in the Probate Court for Greenville County. Lula W. Hendrix died intestate July 29, 1946 survived by the aforesaid children as her sole heirs at law as will appear by reference to Apartment No. 518, File No. 1 in the aforesaid Probate Court.

Mary H. McCuen, one of the children of E. B. Hendrix and Lula W. Hendrix, died January 10, 1962 leaving of force her Last Will and Testament whereby she devised her interest in the above-described property to her daughter, Jean M. Gaillard, the grantor herein. Reference is made to the records on file in the Greenville County Probate Court in Apartment 782, File 6.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee, and the grantee's heirs or successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor does hereby bind the grantor and the grantor's heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee and the grantee's heirs or successors and assigns, against the grantor and the grantor's heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
