LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

NOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, ROBERT E. PINCHER (hereinafter at times referred to as the "Principal"), domiciled and residing in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being desirous of appointing an Attorney-in-Fact to act for me in the matter specified hereinbelow, do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint ANDREW J. WHITE, JR., my true and lawful Attorney-in-Fact, for the sole purpose of transferring any and all assets standing in my name or owned by me to THE CITIZENS AND SOUTHERN NATIONAL BANK OF SOUTH CAROLINA and WAYNE H. CHAPMAN as Trustees of that certain Agreement and Declaration of Trust dated the 18th day of December, 1984 by and between ROBERT E. PINCHER, as Grantor, and THE CITIZENS AND SOUTHERN NATIONAL BANK OF SOUTH CAROLINA and WAYNE H. CHAPMAN, as Trustees.

The power herein conferred may be exercised by my said Attorney alone, and his signature or act in my behalf may be accepted by third persons as fully authorized by me, and with the same force and effect as if done under my hand and seal and as if I were present in person and acting in my own behalf.

And I do hereby ratify and confirm each and every act and thing which my Attorney-in-Fact shall and may do by virtue hereof.

This power of attorney shall remain in full force and effect until revoked by me by endorsement upon the original hereof and by a record of such revocation upon the face of the record of this instrument in the Office of the Clerk of Court or the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance of the county where said instrument is recorded.

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.
