Men by these presents that I Thomas Dugan  
in the State aforesaid in consideration of  
the sum of Three hundred and twenty five  
Dollars to me paid by Samuel Augustus  
Maurick son of Samuel Maurick of  
Charleston in the State aforesaid Merchant  
have granted bargained, sold and released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and release unto the said Samuel Augustus  
Maurick all that piece parcel and  
remainder of a tract of 557 acres of  
Land originally granted to a Maurick  
by Wm Moultrie Governor on 5<sup>th</sup> day February  
1787 bounding at the time of the original  
survey on Alexanders Land the original ancient  
boundary line John Redmans and vacant  
land but by a resurvey made by James  
Kilgore Dept. Survr October 1802 hereunto  
Enored and will more fully shew after running  
off John Redmans Tract granted to him  
21<sup>st</sup> January 1785 leaves a balance of  
three Hundred and twenty six acres be the  
same more or less on the branches of Durband  
Creek of Enore River in Greenville
