death. To have and to hold all and singular
the said two negroes Sam & Annas unto the said
David Smith & Emmilly his wife her heirs forever
to her own proper use & behoof to belong
to and owned by & be enjoyed only by the said
Emmilly Smith & her heirs for ever. And we the
said James Porter & Polly Porter do warrant by
these presents for ever defend the said negroes Sam
& Annas as above described unto the said David &
Emmilly Smith his heirs forever In witness
whereof we have set our hands &
Seals this twenty second day of February 1822
