Greenville District that I Thomas Benson of the State &  
District aforesaid for the consideration of ninety dollars to me  
in hand paid by Leroy McWhorter of said district and  
State have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell unto the said Leroy McWhorter and his  
heirs one tract or parcel of land containing sixty five acres  
more or less and bounding as follows (viz) lying on the waters of  
Enore River beginning on a poplar at the Creek thence along the  
road to a pine corner thence along to a poplar corner at the  
head of the branch, thence down the branch to a poplar, thence  
across the said branch over to another branch, to a gum, thence  
down said branch to the beginning, containing sixty five  
acres more or less, Together with all and singular the rights  
members, hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said Leroy  
McWhorter and his heirs forever. And I do hereby bind myself  
my heirs &c to warrant and forever defend the above  
described land for the use and purpose before men-  
tioned unto the said Leroy McWhorter, from me  
and my heirs and every other person or persons  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or  
my part thereof as witness my hand and  
seal this 27<sup>th</sup> October 1819 Test
