compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons
whomsoever renounce, release and forever relin-
-ish unto the within named John Brown his heirs
and assigns all her interest and estate and also
all her right and claim of dower of in or to all
singular the premises within mentioned and released
giving under my hand and seal this the twenty
sixth day of December 1820.
