to John Watsons Land thence along Watsons line
to Tiger River, up D^d river to Jesse Pectors Land along
Pectors line so far as to strike the beginning corner
& take in seventy two acres of Land together with
all and singular the rights hereditaments & appur
tenances to said seventy two acres of Land which
Land is valued at one hundred dollars, be lanning or
in any wise incident or appertaining to have and
to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned to the D^d Jesse Cannon his heirs and
assigns forever & I do bind my self my heirs & assigns
