Atkinson his heirs Exors administrators & assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land situated and lying in the District aforesaid on the waters of Horse pen creek and waters of gilders creek containing one hundred acres more or less including a spring on said horse pen creek, being part of a tract of Land granted to James Barton, bearing date 21 day of September 1792. beginning at a Chesnut 3x on the Ridge Road thence up the meanders of said to a Stake 3x. thence South 45 E 26.50 to a Red oak 3x thence N 25 E 65 to a pine 3x. thence a direct to the beginning Chesnut corner binding on lands of Henry Stokes John Shackston, Bartlet Yeargin Eli Balding. Together with all and singular the Right members tenements and hereditaments therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining therunto to have and to have and to hold the above tract of Land with all and singular the premises above mentioned and appertaining

unto the said William A. Atkinson, his heirs Exors, administrators & assigns. the Lawful claim of any person whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof as witness my hand and seal this 23rd Febr 1822. Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us.
