tion of the sum of two hundred dollars to me  
in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby ac-  
knowledged, have granted, bargained, sold  
and released, and by these presents do grant  
bargain, sell and release confirm and con-  
vey, unto Carey M. Jackson all that plantation  
tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the  
District aforesaid on the waters of Pack, Creek  
of South Tyger River it being a part of a tract  
of land granted to Keuben Barrett; and by him  
conveyed to Archabald Dill, and by him con-  
veyed to Hummel Dill, and by him conveyed  
to John Dill Beginning on a sowerwood cor-  
ner at the head of his Spring branch, thence down  
the said branch to a white oak corner, thence to  
a stake, thence to a stake on Pack, Creek, thence  
along Washington Carlens land to Henry Pines  
line, thence along said line to a post oak  
corner, thence to the beginning corner  
the same being eighty acres more or less  
together with all and singular the
