 -dred dollars to me paid by William Morris
 of the said State and District have granted
 bargained, sold and released, and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said William Morris all that plan-
 -tation or tract of land containing ninety
 -eight acres (or the same more or less) of
 situate in the state and district aforesaid
 on the south side of Mountain Creek waters of
 Saluda River beginning on a black oak 3x
 thence S 46 18.70 to a pine corner thence
 S 10 10 35.00 to a hickory 3x thence S 60 W
 21.50 to a stake 3x thence N 35 W 9.00 to a
 stake 3x thence S 17 E 51.80 to the begin-
 -ning being part of a tract of 623 acres of
 land originally granted to John Martin
 on the third day of September 1787. Togeth-
 -er with all and singular the rights mem-
 -ber, hindrances and appurtenances
 to the said premises belonging or in any
