 due 1st day of January 1825 for one hundred dollars, which
 notes are lost or misplaced so that they cannot be found.

 -eration of five hundred dollars to me paid by Thomas
 Langley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 granted bargain sold and released unto the said Thomas
 Langley all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in
 the District aforesaid on the South side of South Tyger River
 beginning on a hickory on the bank of the River on David Balfors
 line thence down the meanders of the River to a small cherry
 tree thence No. 75 N. 77 to a hickory thence No. 41 N. 81 to a hickory
 thence S. 42 N. 20 to a post oak thence S. 13 N. 13 to a chestnut thence
 N. 75 to a post oak thence No. 78 N. 5 to a chestnut thence N. 86
 N. 20 S. 75 to a red oak thence No. 40 & E. 38 to the beginning con-
 -taining one hundred and seventy seven acres, be the same more
 or less the same being conveyed from Moses Swafford to Sa-
 -ra Springfield and from him to Thomas Langley Together
 with all and singular the rights appurtenances hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
 wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Langley
 -ley his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself
 my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and fore-
 -or defend all and singular the said premises unto the
 said Thomas Langley his heirs and assigns against myself
 and my heirs with a gainst every person whatsoever to my
 Claiming or to Claim the same or any part thereof
